

<p>Restrictions on the shape and design of a building (Colors of the external appearance)</p>	<p>1. The color of the roof and outer wall of a building are restricted to those in the table below, except for the part of the building which fall within either of the following items.</p> <p>Colors are specified based on the hue, value and chroma provided in the Munsell color system (Japan Industrial Standard Z8721).</p> <p>① The area less than one fifth of each wall</p> <p>② The part of the building made up with the products grown or made in the local area or the materials that have traditionally been used as a part of the building such as timber, bricks, concrete and stones. Colored materials are excluded.</p> <p>2. Chroma of the colors of the attachments to a building such as a wall and fence must be as low as that of the building.</p> <p>3. The design of the attachment to a building such as a garage and trash box must harmonize with that of the building.</p> <p>2. The design of the external electrical equipment and other machineries and that of the building must be the same kind. A kerosene tank, shed for propane gas cylinder and out door unit of the air conditioner must be hidden where they won't be seen, otherwise their design must harmonize with that of the building.</p> <p>3. If the annex is build to the building not applicable to the above two provisions due to the Clause 2, Article 69 of the Landscape Law, only the annex is applicable to the above provisions due to the Item 2, Clause 3 or the same article, and the building is not applicable to them.</p>
